

EQUINE ASSISTED THERAPY GROUP

<u>First part of the session</u> – Parents & children participate in Experiential learning utilizing horses (Equine Assisted Therapy). No riding for this program.

<u>Second part of the session</u> – Parents engage in support group/collaboration. Children are offered pony rides after last session.

\$100 per session for parents and one child.

Must commit to all 6 sessions, payment due at signup.
